Mountain View Fire will be conducting training at old Dacono Community Center

The Mountain View Fire Protection District will be conducting valuable training at the old Community Center in Dacono, 106 4th street.

The city of Dacono has offered up the building for emergency services to train in before the building is demolished and area departments are grateful for the opportunity.

The trainings will be conducted periodically from June 10th- August 15th from 8am- 7 pm. Officials note though that four of the days will go until 10pm but noise will be minimal during those later times.

Jesse Hodgson, spokesman for Mountain View says that this will provide extremely beneficial training to both the police and fire departments.

“This structure provided the city and its residents a lot of memories and we want people to know that their fire department will be better for the opportunity we have to train with this building.

The trainings will not include any live fire activities nor will it be burned down when the training is complete. However, Hodgson says that smoke producing theatrical fog machines will be used to replicate smoky environments for firefighters.

The building will remain secured when it's not in use.

Anyone with questions or concerns is asked to contact the City of Dacono's administration offices, located at 512 Cherry Street during normal business hours.

“We just want neighbors in the area of that building to know that we will be there for a couple months conducting this training” concluded Hodgson.
