



Frequently Asked Questions Mountain View's hiring process 2011

If I don't submit all the certifications by the application deadline, can I still apply?

Mountain View requires that applicants meet **all** minimum requirements. If you are missing any minimum requirements the application will not be considered.

I took CPAT with another agency, will you accept this certification?

MVFPD accepts CPAT certifications obtained thru other agencies. However, CPAT certification obtained prior to September 1, 2010 will not be accepted. No exceptions. Applicants will be required to obtain a CPAT certification through another agency by May 2, 2011.

I took the DRCOG test in June 2010, will you use that score?

DRCOG scores will be accepted from the June and November 2010 test date. If you haven't taken the DRCOG test in 2010 you will not be eligible to continue the hiring process.

How long does the hiring process take?

The hiring process will take approximately 5 months from the application deadline until offers are made or a career hiring list is created.

What are the steps in Mountain View's hiring process?

Each hiring process, whether it is Career, Paid Part Time or Volunteer, has their own separate timeline. Refer to the hiring process timeline on each individual recruitment page.

I would like to apply for more than one position with Mountain View, can I do that?

As long as the minimum requirements are met per position applied for, then you may apply for more than one position. Indicate which position(s) you are applying for on the checklist page of your application.
