- a. MVFPD and RMF Combined Volunteer Pension – Fourth Quarter 2024 Financials
Finance Director Tonya Olson reported on the financials for the Mountain View Volunteer Pension and the Rocky Mountain Fire Volunteer Pension. She updated the Board that there are 64 members receiving benefits and four future members who will be eligible under the Mountain View Plan, and 26 members receiving benefits with no future members in the Rocky Mountain Fire Plan. After discussion, Director Whitlow moved to approve the Fourth Quarter 2024 Financials for the MVFPD and RMF Combined Volunteer Pension. It was seconded by Director Venrick and carried unanimously, and was followed by a roll call.

Director Lathrop followed up on a request from the December 10, 2024, meeting regarding verification with FPPA about increasing the benefit for the volunteer funds. Ms. Olson stated that the deadline for the actuarial study has passed and will be tabled until later in the year.

Allocation Report

Investment Performance
